REGISTRATION

PLEASE BRING YOUR CURRENT LICENCE OR GREEN SLIP TO REGISTRATION. Registration will be at the following times:

Friday from 12 noon to 6pm (preferred)

Saturday from 9am until 12 noon sharp.

Please register on Friday if at all possible; this will help us to avoid any delays on Saturday.

You only need to register once.

A single, combined Registration process will cover both the Probikx/Chambikx and the Vic State Titles events.

There will be no Registration on Sunday

NUMBER PLATES

At Registration on Friday from 12 noon to 6pm and Saturday from 9am until 12 noon all riders will be issued with their DK BICYCLES race plate, race numbers and zip ties. **These plates must be affixed prior to practice** as they signify which practice session you can participate in and that you are properly entered and registered.

Riders who are entered in the 2011 Rock Energy Drinks Champbikx/Probikx National Series round 2 as well as the DK BICYCLES 2010 VICTORIAN OPEN BMX CHAMPIONSHIPS may practice using their Champbikx/Probikx number plate, but must attend Registration first.

TRANSPONDERS

All riders **except Sprockets** will require a transponder. These will be fitted after you have registered. Riders will receive one transponder only. **If you are riding 24" & 20" bring your Cruiser to Registration** to have the transponder fitted. If you are only riding in 20" then bring your that bike to Registration. Riders riding two classes will need to remove the transponder from your Cruiser at the end of the Saturday's racing and attach it to your 20" for Sunday.

Riders owning their own transponder must bring their bike to Registration with the transponder fitted so that it can be checked at the transponder fitting station.

If you are sharing a bike with another rider you must notify Registration in advance registrar@bmxv.com.au

FRIDAY OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Official Practice on Friday will run from 1pm until 8pm

Riders will be divided into broad age groups such as Sprockets, 8-13, 14+ (*not including AA*) & AA as they come through Staging. Lanes will be marked in Staging and you must enter the Starting area using the correct lane for your Age group or class.

AA Riders will get additional exclusive use of the track for practice between 6 – 6:20pm & 7:10-7:30pm

Shirts must be tucked in, sleeves rolled down and helmets done up properly before entering the Starting area. Any riders who do not comply with this may be instructed to get leave the starting gate area. The Starters will not wait for them to get ready.

As per the BMXA rule for Sprocket riders *"A rider who elects to use an interlocking pedal cleat system will not use a block or be assisted from the rear of the start hill."* ie. a Sprocket rider using 'cleat pedals' may not be supported on the Start gate.

SCRUTINEERING

Random scrutineering will be carried out throughout the event, please ensure your bike and riding gear meets BMXA guidelines.

CAR PARKING - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Please follow the signs and marshals.

There will be a speed limit of 40kph in Old Wells Road throughout the duration of the event which will be policed .

There will be some parking within the track on a first come, first served basis. There will be a 'gold coin donation' charged for parking inside the track area.

NOTWITHSTANDING THE SPEED LIMIT OUTSIDE THE TRACK, OLD WELLS ROAD IS NOT SAFE FOR RIDERS TO WARMUP/WARM DOWN, OR OTHERWISE RIDE ON. ANY RIDERS FOUND RIDING ON THE ROAD MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE EVENT.
