



# BMX Victoria

## 2012 Junior State Series Rules

2012 BMX Victoria Junior State Series are Class 7 events run to UCI BMX rules with Australian Regional Applications (transfers as Section: 4E.1.i and 4E.4.i)

2012 BMX Victoria Junior State Series events are incorporated into BMX Victoria sanctioned open events; specific entry conditions of each host club event are also applicable.

### 1. *Preamble*

2012 BMXV Junior Series overview:

- open to Victorian licensed riders aged 8 to 13
- six round series incorporated into existing sanctioned open events on the BMXV calendar
- separate additional 20 inch race class to those offered by the host sanctioned open event.
  - o mandatory that BMXV Junior State Series entrants also nominate for age and/or cruiser at host sanctioned open event
- ranking plates awarded 1 – 8 in each BMXV Junior State Series age class.
- rider with the highest points in their BMXV Junior State Series class will be:
  - o 2012 BMX Vic Junior State Series Champion (in that class)

### 2. *Age Determination*

UCI Year of Birth for all BMXV Junior Series classes, i.e. age at 31st December 2012.

### 3. *Age Groups/Classes*

Following 20" classes are offered:

- Boys: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 (6 classes)
- Girls: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 (6 classes)

Three riders constitute a class.

A rider will earn series points when competing in their year of birth age class or when classes are combined, they will receive series points for motos in merged class and final series points for their normal age class.

### 4. *Format*

Three moto's and finals/4th moto.

No consolation / invitation finals will be run for classes with 9 or more entries.

### 5. *Entry Fees / Requirements*

Entry to the BMXV Junior Series is FREE.

It is mandatory that BMXV Junior Series entrants also nominate and pay for age and/or cruiser at the host sanctioned open event. Riders must also have a guardian sign to accept conditions entry to the host sanctioned open event.



## **6. Qualifying / Ranking – all classes**

No minimum rounds to qualify.

Total score from 6 rounds count for ranking.

**A rider must be scored in at least 1 moto in order to use the round as a qualifier for the Series.**

## **7. Awards**

Riders ranked 1-8 in all classes participating in this series receive a ranking plate.

Ranking plates / numbers can be used for one year or the end of the next series, whichever is sooner..

## **8. Nominations**

Nominations will be available by either:

- postal entries for the full series or individual rounds
- on-line entry for individual rounds when riders also enter age class.

Entry lists for all events control will be controlled by the BMX Victoria series coordinator.

Riders are to register for each round.

## **11. Series Scoring**

Notwithstanding anything contained in the current UCI BMX Rules and Australian Procedures Manual (As Amended) the following rules apply to the BMX Victoria Junior Series 2012

10 bonus points will be awarded for each round entered.

### **Classes of over 9:**

Series points will be based on moto ranking placing and finals placing (position in Semis will be included in ranking).

### **Classes of 8 or less:**

Series points will be based on the riders placing after the 4th moto.



**Scoring System:**

Series placing points are gained as per the following:

1st – 8pts

2nd – 7pts

3rd – 6pts

4th – 5pts

5th – 4pts

6th – 3pts

7th – 2pts

8th – 1pt

**In the event of a tie the riders overall position will be decided by a count back.**

**DNF** will score last place in the moto/final.

**DNS** will score 8<sup>th</sup> place in the moto/final.

**Points Information** - The series point's information will be posted on the BMX Victoria Website (<http://www.bmxv.com.au>) and kept up to date throughout the series.
