NEW FORMAT FOR THE "INTERCLUB" CHALLENGE"

The Interclub Challenge will be a normal race meeting with 3 Motos and Finals for all riders.

The **Interclub Challenge Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded on the basis of a Teams Challenge. Each BMX Victoria club may nominate a team of up to ten riders. The best results of 8 of these riders over the first three Motos will determine which club receives the Interclub Challenge Perpetual Trophy. Team riders may only be nominated by their club.

INTERCLUB TEAMS RELAY

The relay race will run at the start of the event . Each club will nominate one team for this challenge - see your Club Secretary for more information.

You don't have to ride two classes - Just ride what you usually ride.

Riders enter themselves, then their club's nominate which riders represent the club in the relay and for team points throughout the day.

The aim of the day is to ride, have fun & most importantly, raise some money for the nominated charity.

- Racing :** – 11.00 am Interclub Teams Relay first up
– Three (3) Motos; plus Finals for all classes

- Age 20”:** 8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19-29,30-39,40-49, 50+

- Pro 20”:** 14+ Men, 14+ Women (will compete to win the perpetual trophy)

CLUB TEAM RELAY - RULES

1. Clubs may enter one team only.
2. Clubs entering a team pay the nominal \$15 fee, not the riders.
3. All entry fees go to the nominated charity
4. Relay team competitors must compete in the event held on the day
5. Clubs with less than 20 licensed riders can make a Composite Team with another club also having less than 20 licensed riders.
6. 20" or Cruiser bikes permitted.
7. One trophy will be awarded to the winning club.
8. RACE FORMAT:
 - (a) 8 teams or less - one race before first Moto
 - (b) More than 8 teams - Elimination race before first Moto then the top team from each heat transfer to a tie-breaker race.
 - (c) Starting order for riders in each team as per entry form above, ie first rider is '16 & Over', then '13 -15' rider, and so on.
9. Team points from the Club Challenge relay will not be awarded to any other event on the day.
10. The Team Manager shall ensure that the team is assembled and ready to race at the appropriate time.
11. The Team Finish Line official shall raise a flag to indicate when a team member has crossed the Finish Line so that the next team member can start. (Why not bring your own flag in your Club colours?).
12. After crossing the Finish Line the last member of each team will line up in the appropriate finishing position to have the teams placing recorded.
13. Penalties may be awarded to teams at the discretion of the Chief Steward. Any Team Manager wishing to appeal a decision of the Chief Steward must lodge a Protest Fee of \$50. This fee will be donated to charity.

2012 Interclub Challenge - Club Teams entry form

TEAM ENTRY FORM AND RULES

1. Any BMX Victorian affiliated Club can enter one Club Team into this event.
2. Each Club must appoint a Team Manager who will be responsible for the registration and entry of the team.
3. Each club team must consist of **up to** ten(10) riders, drawn from their current club membership. Riders must hold a current BMXA licence and have paid their BMX Victoria affiliation and club membership. All eligible members can compete.
4. Each Club can enter only one Club Team and each team rider may only be nominated for one class in which to score Team points. This class must be nominated before racing starts.
5. All riders competing for a team must have been asked personally by the Team Manager and have entered the event via online or by postal entry prior to close of entry.
6. Points from only the top eight (8) riders in each Club Team will be counted to determine the winning club.
7. Each club team will receive points for their placing in each of the first three (3) Motos raced, as follows:

1 st = 20 points	5 th = 12 points
2 nd = 18 points	6 th = 10 points
3 rd = 16 points	7 th = 8 points
4 th = 14 points	8 th = 6 points

Participation class (Sprockets): 10 points (irrespective of actual placing).
Only Motos 1, 2 & 3 are scored. No points are scored for Finals or the 4th Moto.
8. Substitution of riders after acceptance of entry will be permitted by advising the Scoring Coordinator of a substitute rider to replace a nominated team member who is unable to compete in the event due to an injury. This must be done at least 1 hour before the start of racing on Sunday, 12th February 2012.
9. The Entry Form with nominations of team riders for your clubs team must be emailed to registrar@bmxv.com.au and received no later than 8.00pm on Thursday 09/02/12. If not received by close of entry their club's team will not be eligible to compete in the 2012 BMX Victoria Interclub Challenge Teams event.
10. In the event of a tie between Teams, the result will be decided by countback. The decision of the Event Management Group will be final.
11. Posting of Club Team results will be announced shortly after the conclusion of racing.
12. It is the Team Manager's responsibility to check the posted results against their own calculations and if they disagree to lodge a protest with the Scoring Coordinator within fifteen minutes of the posting of the official team results at the conclusion of the Victorian Interclub. Failure to lodge a protest within fifteen minutes of the posting will result in forfeiture of the right to have any protest heard in relation to team's scores. A protest fee of \$50 must be lodged; this will go to charity.

15. The BMX Victoria Interclub Challenge Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winning Club Team.
