# PRO RACING FORMAT

The PRA is a register of all Pro riders to promote a constant in participation numbers. All Pro riders in the state would register their intent to compete in the series. This will enable a structured race series for Pro racing in Victoria.

As of now there is little structure to Pro racing in VIC, there are numerous open meetings throughout the year that are all scored on an individual basis. To find out who are the best Pro Riders in the State a structured series is needed, and to be scored accordingly.

The Pro classes would be: AA, A, Vet Pro open wheel, Pro Women. All these classes are OPEN. There would be 5 race series on tracks with air ram operating gate system, this is the riders wish. This is to retain a consistency with the gates between the different tracks and a logistic and safety constant.

The Riders will be scored for the series by the PRA points system. Once the series has run and the final points have been tallied, the top 8 riders in each class will race a one off extra final 'TOP 8 SHOOTOUT' for the bonus money which has been accumulated through the series.

**ENTRIES:** the host club is to have discretion on how the entries are to taken, any financial burden on the host club i.e.: online entries are to be taken out of the pro payback classes providing expenses are accounted for.

There have to be minimum entries per class for this series to work, and be financially viable. Good promotion by the clubs and the PRA is a priority.

AA Pro min entries to be 16 riders	\$50 entry fee
A Pro min entry to be 20 riders	\$40 entry fee
Vet Pro O W min entries 20 riders	\$35 entry fee
Pro women min entries 10 riders	\$35 entry fee

80% of the entry money goes to payback on the day. Less applicable fees (BMXV, Online etc)

20% of the entry money goes to end of series TOP 8 SHOOTOUT kitty.

All entry money would go to club with the shootout money to be held in the PRA funds.

Any money contributed by the host club would be split the same way 80/20 if the host club for that round so chooses.

Any money contributed by a sponsor will be split the same way, 80/20 at the sponsor/clubs discretion if they choose this option they will be advertised and promoted throughout the whole series.

A breakdown of entries as follows: example only

Vet Pro 20 Riders @ \$35 Entry fee = \$700	80% to payback on day =	\$560
	20% to TOP 8 SHOOTOUT =	\$140
Pro Women 10 Riders @ \$35 Entry = \$350	80% to payback on day =	\$280
	20% to TOP 8 SHOOTOUT =	\$70

All payback on the day money will be less applicable fees (BMXV, online etc)

Please note: any club/sponsor money has not been factored in! The totals will change with any extra funding.

The incentive for clubs is that the attendance of a structured Pro Race Series would attract the expert riders and sprockets, which means more parents, guardians, spectators to sell food and drinks to through your canteen. Also it relieves the burden of finding large sums of prize money for the Pro's.

A club can contribute a smaller amount of prize money to the purse. This would mean greater profits on race day and also help to further Pro racing in VIC, as most clubs have pro's in their membership.

The PRA register is designed to promote Pro racing in VIC, which will in turn help the expert riders and the Sprockets of VIC, due in large to the extra commitments from the Pro riders to be more pro active at club level with coaching and mentoring.

With the help of the clubs and especially the Riders this series and BMX in VIC can grow over the next few years, as we all know every successful sport has Pro's that the everyday person and beginner [experts and sprockets as in our sport] to look up to and aspire to be. This will benefit the whole BMX community.
