***The above entry fees include a \$10 transponder hire fee (not applicable to Sprockets) for the first class entered. Riders entering more than one class pay \$10 less per class for their 2nd or 3rd classes.**

Riders with their own transponder must list its number on the entry form, and will receive a refund of \$10 at Registration.

No late entries, no excuses.

Please allow ample time for Australia Post.

Postal entries close at receipt of last mail on Friday 14th October 2011. No phone entries will be accepted.

Online entries close at midnight Friday 21st October 2011.

Transponders

All scoring will be by transponder. All riders (except Sprockets) will be issued with a transponder for which they will be charged a hire fee of \$10. This charge is built into the price of the first class entered. Where the race organiser provides/hires transponders for electronic lap timing, it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike. There will be a transponder fitting & testing station at Registration. Transponders must be returned to the race organiser at the conclusion of the event and failure to do so will incur a cost to the rider of \$150 plus costs. Riders owning their own MyLaps Cycle Pro Chip transponder who list it on their entry will receive a refund of \$10 at Registration.

Riders competing in both Cruiser and 20" classes will use the same transponder for both bikes. **If you are sharing a bike with another rider you must notify Registration in advance registrar@bmxv.com.au**

Registration, Scrutineering, Practice

All riders must register and produce their current BMXA licence

Registration :

Motos will be drawn after close of Registration.

Scrutineering : Random scrutineering will be conducted throughout the event.

Saturday	Sprockets & Cruisers	9:00 am to Mid Day (see Final Instructions for groups)

Full regulation protective clothing must be worn and all competitors must have the supplied number plate fitted to their bike during practice and racing.





Conditions of Entry

- 1) All riders must hold a current Sprocket or Open BMXA licence.
- 2) All riders will be provided with a number plate and numbers for this event. Bikes not displaying the supplied number plate will not be permitted on the track. It is a condition of entry that this plate be used for the entire race meeting and other than numbers or stickers supplied by the organisers, no other numbers or stickers may be attached to the plate.
- 3) Five (5) riders to constitute a class except in Sprocket classes where any number will be deemed a class. If insufficient entries are received to form a Class at closing date, riders will be allocated to the most appropriate Class.
- 4) Determination of age is age as per 31st December 2011. Riders must enter their natural age class.
- 5) Race number: All riders holding a current World, National, State or UCI number may nominate it, (*for example W1, 3A, 8V, 5SA*). All other riders will be issued with a number for the event.
- 6) No refunds, unless:
 - a) it is found after the close of entries that a rider's nominated Class is not available; or
 - b) a rider is injured or becomes ill prior to the event and produces a medical certificate, in which case an administration fee will be deducted.
- 7) It is the riders' responsibility:
 - a) to check if an entry has been received. Entry lists will be progressively updated on the BMXV web site www.bmxv.com.au.
 - b) to register, check Moto sheets or Points Café, attend Staging on time and ride in their correct Moto. Riders who fail to register will not be included in Moto draw. Invitational finals will not be run in any classes.
- 8) No run-offs will be run. In the case of riders with equal points, positions will be determined by a count-back.
- 9) **UCI Rule 6.1.098** Riders will be held accountable for the actions of their parents, team managers and any other persons in their company at a BMX competition or event. Any misconduct on the part of any of these persons may, at the discretion of a Race Commissaire or Race Director, result in the disqualification or suspension of the rider and the removal of the offending persons from the track area.

Final Instructions

Final instructions for practice groups and times, race format, presentation format etc will be posted online at www.bmxv.com.au after the close of entries. Riders entering online will receive notification via email.
