



Final Instruction for Last Chance Meeting 2010

Please read carefully

Registration and Transponder Fitting

Please see attached map for details on where Registration is taking place and transponder fitting. As this is a transponder event we do recommend you register as early as possible. Registration times are 12.00pm – 5.00pm Saturday and by advance request on Sunday. If you need to register on Sunday you must email lyndon.downing@bigpond.com no later than **Thursday the 29th of April.**

All riders are reminded that you must bring your license to registration and when scanned confirm the details of your entry.

Race Plates

All bikes must have a plate fitted to the bike during practice and racing. The plate must be regulation background colour with the correct coloured numbers for the rider's class

Transponders

All riders **except Sprockets** will require a transponder. These will be fitted after you have registered. Riders will receive one transponder only. **If you are riding two classes bring your 20" bike to Registration** to have the transponder fitted. If you are only riding Cruiser class then they need to bring your Cruiser. **Riders riding two classes will need to remove the transponder from your 20" at the end of the 20" block and attach it to your Cruiser.** Riders will be given instructions on how to do this. ***Important - If you are riding in the next weeks National Titles you must keep your transponder for that meeting. Any rider not riding the National Titles must return the transponder once race commitments at the Last Chance Meeting are completed.*** Any rider who loses or does not return their transponder will be liable to pay \$150 for its replacement

Tent Sites

The marquees for the National Titles will be set up for the Last Chance meeting.

Car Parking

There will be no cars or trailers parked in the BMX Track facility or in the immediate surrounds. Please follow the signage for parking areas in use. Parking will incur a gold coin donation.

Awards

Awards for Challenge & Cruiser classes will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd; these awards will be presented over the line. A men, AA men and Pro ladies will have an awards ceremony 15 minutes at the end of their final.

Pay back for 30+ Masters will be \$20 per rider entered.

Prize money for the 14+ plus Women, A & AA men will be a prize pool of \$2000.

If racing is delayed for any period of time, a decision may be made to drop motos to complete the meeting

Bindies-

We warn all riders that there are sections of ground outside the BMX track that have Bindies. These prickles can cause punctures, we recommend that when you take your bike to Registration you carry your bike and stay on the concrete path.
