What is the Interclub Challenge?

A serious fun day of racing to enable riders to race on the State Championships track.

All racing is scored for points for your home club with the highest points earning club being awarded the **Interclub Challenge Perpetual Trophy**.

The points scored by each club for race results are adjusted by a formula based on the percentage of the clubs number of licenced riders who actually race on the day.

So bring both bikes (or arrange a loan of a cruiser/20") and get the points for your club while having some fun.

Registration	– 9.00 to 10.30 am (<i>Entrants not registered by 10.30 will be removed from draw</i>)
Practice	– 9.00 to 10.30 am (<i>In age class groups</i>)
Racing	– 11.00 am Interclub Teams Relay Challenge – Three (3) Motos; plus finals only for Pro-Am classes (<i>no finals for age classes</i>)

Classes

Sprockets:	Under 5, 5 yrs, 6 yrs, 7 yrs.
Age 20”:	8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19-24,25-29,30-34,35-39,40-44,45-49,50+
Age cruiser:	8-10,11-12,13-14,15-16,17-18,19-24,25-29,30-34,35-39,40-44,45-49,50+
Pro-Am 20”:	Pro-Am men, Pro-Am women.

Note: Age for this event is year of event minus year of birth

Three (3) riders to constitute a class except in sprocket classes where any number will be deemed a class. *Subject to entries, separate male and female classes will be run.*
Riders may enter two classes only

Interclub Teams Relay Challenge – Zaidee Rainbow Foundation Cup

A relay event consisting of one qualifying round and one final round.

Each club may enter a Team of four riders:

- One 16 year or over rider
- One 13 to 15 year rider
- One 8 to 12 year rider
- One rider of any competition age

Each club must provide a starter and finish line manager for it's team.

Riders will compete in the order listed above, with the first riders starting with the gate and the subsequent riders starting off the start hill when signalled by the finish line manager.
