Race Format:

3 motos and Finals *run in ‘Block format’**

5 Riders constitute a class.

Classes less than 8 riders will run dead man finals

**‘Block format’ means that all Cruiser classes will be run in a block and all 20” Classes will be run in a separate block. Riders riding both will need to transfer their transponder from bike to bike between blocks. The same applies for practice and for racing.*

Transponders:

All competition classes will race with Transponders.

Competitors with own MYLAPS Cycle ProChip transponders receive a \$5.00 discount on entry

Where the race organiser provides/hires transponders for electronic lap timing, it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike.

Transponders must be returned to the race organiser at the conclusion of the event and failure to do so will incur a cost to the rider of \$150 plus costs.

Riders competing in the BMX Victoria event on May 2nd who are also entered in the National Championships will retain the transponder issued for the BMX Victoria event for use at the National Championships. Riders competing in only the BMX Victoria event must return their transponders at the completion of that event. Only 1x transponder will be issued to each rider. Competitors racing in 20" & Cruiser classes will have to transfer their transponder between bikes between Cruiser & 20" practice sessions and race Motos.

Riders who are sharing a bike must advise the BMXV Registrar of the details so that correct transponder assignments can be made. BMXV Registrar email = licences@bmxv.com.au

Victorian Dynamite Series:

The Last Chance will incorporate the 1st round of the Victorian Dynamite series. This series is for Victorian riders who will turn 11, 12 & 13 yrs old in **2011**. This round will be a double points round and points will be scored for Motos as well as finals.

There is no separate entry for the Victorian Dynamite Series. All riders in the applicable Age classes will be automatically entered in and scored for the Dynamite Series too.
