

METRO PLATE SERIES 2009

The 2009 Metro Plate will be run as part of the Eastern Regions Clubs Sanctioned Meetings.

No additional entry fees will apply at each race meeting, just enter the appropriate age classes and be scored for the Metro Plate

Age classes to be offered as part of Metro Plate

Sprockets

20 inch 8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19-29, 30-44, 45+, male and female

Cruiser 8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, 19-29, 30-44, 45+, male and female

There will be no money classes as part of the Metro Plate as this will be part of the open event. Money Classes and other extra classes (such as Vouchers, Pit Bikes, Mtb) which may be offered at open events will not be counted for the Metro Plate series.

Riders with a Sprocket or Open BMXA Licence are eligible to participate in the series.

Riders will ride age as of 31 Dec 2009 as per BMXA rules

Riders who turn eight during the series must start the series in the Sprocket Class and move to an 8 Year old Class after their birthday.

SERIES POINTS

To qualify for the end of Series points, riders must enter and pay for the same age class in a minimum of 5 of the 7 sanctioned race meets within the Eastern Region.

Result based series points are recorded from 4 motos from each meeting using the following point's scheme.

Place	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th
Points	10	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

Riders receive 3 bonus points from each of the seven rounds in which they compete.

For age class series awards, a rider's total Series Points are calculated from:

all seven rounds, plus bonus points from all rounds. Any ties at the end of the series will be awarded equally.

Any sprocket riders turning 8 will receive 3 bonus points for every meeting they have competed in as a sprocket plus normal results based points gained after advancement.

To gain series points on wet days, riders must be entered and ride at least the first moto.

If racing is washed out, points will count from completed motos plus the bonus points on competing.

AWARDS

Trophy boards will be available at each round to be purchased by riders for \$ 30

Mini Metro Plate disc and name plates will be handed out after the 5th round to riders that have purchased boards.

At the final Eastern Region Clubs round – series awards will be presented as part of the event to riders who have qualified.

Special awards are available for riders who have qualified in the Metro Plate Series for a consecutive ten or more years.
