GENERAL INFORMATION

Conditions of Entry

1. BMXA rules apply *plus* special Eastern Region of Victoria "Track Attack 2012" conditions of entry.
2. Eastern Region of Victoria's "Track Attack 2012" event is a series of 6 race meetings.
3. Age Determination - Year of Birth, i.e. Age at 31 December 2012.
4. All meetings are *pre-entry* meetings – *no entries on the day* except by special and generous consideration by the Entry Officials of the day and strictly only into classes constituted at close of regular entries (Friday 6th January 2012).
5. Registration: Non-Money class TA12 Series entrants need only register at Event 1 (Knox). However, Money Class entrants MUST register at each separate event. Riders who ride individual rounds (i.e. not as a series entry) must also register at each meeting by the advertised time. (riders must present their current BMXA licence) Any riders who fail to register may be deleted from the Moto sheets for that meeting.
6. Entrants that subsequently withdraw from racing (e.g. due to illness) must inform the registrar as soon as practical to ensure their name is removed from subsequent meetings race sheets. No refunds without a medical certificate.
7. Five (5) riders constitute a class.
8. Meeting formats - 3 Motos and 4th Moto/Finals – Deadman Finals for semis/quarters etc.
9. Series Trophies for Age, Cruiser & Sprocket rocket class riders who have entered the series.
10. Bonus points towards the *Bonus Pool* will be given to Money & Voucher Classes at the 6 meetings – Qualification for the *Bonus Pool* will be based on points awarded for Motos 1 to 3 only at the 6 rounds as follows: 5 points for entering the event *plus* 12 points for 1st, 10 points for 2nd, 8 points for 3rd, 6 points for 4th, 4 points for 5th, 3 points for 6th, 2 points for 7th, 1 point for 8th. **To be eligible for Bonus Pool prize money, a rider must compete at all rounds.**
11. Bonus Pool split – All Money Classes The *Bonus Pool* will be split among the top 8 eligible riders in each Class as follows - 1st – 33%, 2nd – 23%, 3rd - 14%, 4th – 8%, 5th – 7%, 6th –6%, 7th – 5%, 8th 4%.
12. Age Class and Cruiser series awards:
 - To qualify for a series award, riders must compete in the same class for all rounds.
 - Riders will be automatically scored in any class(es) they enter. Where classes are merged due to low entry numbers, riders will be scored for the series in the class which they entered (not the merged class).
 - Points for the series awards are recorded from the first three Motos at each meeting using the following points scheme: 10 points for 1st, 8 points for 2nd, 6 points for 3rd, 5 points for 4th, 4 points for 5th, 3 points for 6th, 2 points for 7th, 1 point for 8th, plus 3 bonus points for each round at which they compete.
 - Any ties will be determined by count-back.
 - To gain series points on wet days, riders must have entered, registered and ridden at least the first Moto.
 - If racing is washed out, points will count from completed Motos.
 - Injured riders who have entered, paid and produce a Doctors certificate will receive bonus points for the relevant rounds. (Age Classes only).

14+ Women "Supergirls" - Prize Purse = \$400 per race meeting Entry fee \$28.00 per meeting. .	\$420 'Top 8' bonus pool (refer to Conditions of Entry item 10 for eligibility criteria)
A Men - Prize Purse = \$400 per race meeting Entry Fee \$28.00 per meeting. .	\$420 'Top 8' bonus pool (refer to Conditions of Entry item 10 for eligibility criteria)
11-13 years Voucher – Prize Purse = \$200 per race meeting Entry fee \$22.00 per meeting	\$200 'Top 8' bonus pool (refer to Conditions of Entry item 10 for eligibility criteria)
8-10 years Voucher – Prize Purse = \$100 per race meeting Entry fee \$19.00 per meeting.	\$160 'Top 8' bonus pool (refer to Conditions of Entry item 10 for eligibility criteria)

Sprocket Classes – 7 years and under – Entry fee \$14.00 per meeting.

Age Classes – All age classes 8 to 18 years, 19-29, 30 to 39 and 40-49, 50+ years-
Entry fee \$17 per meeting.

Cruiser Classes – classes 8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, 19-29, 30 to 39 and 40-49, 50+ years-
Entry fee \$17 per meeting.

Family Entry Fee discount – POSTAL ONLY

Sprocket, Age 20" and Cruiser class entries may be discounted under the following rules:

- Submission of a family entry may only be done via mail, i.e. cheque - not via the online interface
- Where a family has 3 or more riders in age, Sprocket and/or Cruiser classes at any round, the 3rd and subsequent riders may pay half price for one of these classes each, at that round.
- Entries in money classes do not count in the number of family members for discounts. (But if a rider enters a money class and a Age class – say age Cruiser – the Age class entry does count)
