Entry Rules:-

**Club entry only, 1 Rider from 8 to 10 age group
1 Rider from 11 to 13 age group
1 Rider from 14 to 16 age group
1 rider from 17 plus age group**

**Format:- 2 Semi finals run between motos if
sufficient entries
1 Final to be run during Lunch**

**Prize:- Club: Perpetual Trophy for year
Riders: Winning Team, Trophies**

AGE. CLASSES

All riders compete in all pre-final motos to determine the qualifying order for the finals.

With classes of 7 or more entries, the top 4, 6, 8 or 10 qualifiers (depending on the number of entries in the class) transfer to deadman semi finals. The winners of each semi then compete in a 2 man "1 on 1" final for 1st and 2nd placing's.

Prior to each class's final, additional consolation races will be run for *all other competitors in that class*. The format again depends on the number of competitors in the class, but in all cases the dropout semi finalists will compete in a consolation final. Competitors who did not make the semi finals will also compete in Consolation Finals. *This means that all riders have at least 4 races (5 in the case of finalists and semi finalists).*

Still not sure? - Here's an example.

12 competitors in a class race 3 motos. The top 8 qualifiers are divided into 2 semis. The winners of the 2 semis transfer to the 1 on 1 final, the remaining 6 riders compete in Consolation 1. The 4 riders who did not qualify for the semis compete in Consolation 2.

Note: Classes with 4, 5 or 6 competitors do not have semi finals, but *all competitors get 4 races.*

Notes:

1. Semi final winners transfer to 1 on 1 final.
2. Only non-qualifiers compete in Consolation 2 - n.
3. For these class numbers, Consolation 1 is made up of semi final dropouts plus non-qualifiers
4. For these class numbers, only semi final dropouts compete in Consolation 1.

PRO CLASSES

The format for PRO classes is similar to the above, with all riders competing in all pre-final motos to determine the qualifying order for the finals. The main difference with Finals Code of PRO is that two quarter finals will be run when the number of competitors in the class is 11 or more and only the top ten riders transfer to the finals. NOTE: If less than 9 riders entered in the class then BEM reverts to Finals Code of AGE rules.
