RULES FOR THE 2008 METRO PLATE SERIES

The Metro Plate Series will be run as per BMXA rules as of 01/01/2008

Round 1	9 th August	Park Orchards	Round 5	10 th August	Eastfield

RULES and ELIGIBILITY

1. Riders with a Sprocket or Open BMXA Licence are eligible to participate in the series.
2. Riders with a Club Permit Licence who wish to enter any Metro Plate Event must first upgrade to an Open Licence. Day licences are not valid for this category.
3. Age determination is age on the day of the final round of the series
(Sprocket and 14+ classes excepted per BMXA rules).
4. Riders who turn eight during the series must start the series in the Sprocket Class and move to an 8 Year old Class after their birthday. Any such rider will receive 3 bonus points for every meeting they have competed in as a sprocket plus normal results based points gained after advancement.
5. Each meeting is an Open meeting, organised and run by the Host Club.
6. Three (3) riders constitute a Class (with the exception of vet pro open wheel, see below).
7. Lane draws as per BMXA Rules - random lane draws for qualifying motos and Olympic lane draws for finals.
8. Expert and Invitation deadman finals will apply, subject to there being more than 8 riders in a Class.
9. All riders **must register and produce their BMXA licence** or green slip by no later than 9:30am on the day of the event. Riders who fail to register or produce their licence may be deleted from the race sheets for that event.
10. Vet Pro Open Wheel is open to riders 30 years or over. 20" or 24" (cruiser) – **6 riders at each round are deemed to constitute a class.**
11. **14+ money class and VET PRO open wheel "Frequent Flyers Program":**
The Top Eight series point getters in the class will race for a prize pool at the final round.
The prize pool made up from \$5 deducted from each entry to this class at each round.
The Top Eight will be selected from the entrants to the class for the final round, according to accumulated Series Points determined as in 2. and 3. below.
The Top Eight will race a three final final (no moto's) for the prize pool.
The remainder of entrants in the class at the final round will race "normally" for that rounds prize money (4 motos and finals)

SERIES POINTS

1. To qualify for the end of series award, riders must enter and pay for the same Class in a minimum of four of the first six rounds PLUS the final round.
2. Result based series points are recorded from the first four motos from all meetings using the following points scheme.

Place	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th	8 th
Points	10	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

3. Riders receive 3 bonus points from each of the six preliminary rounds in which they compete.
4. For age class series awards, a rider's total Series Points are calculated from the four highest results based scores from the six preliminary rounds, plus bonus points from the six preliminary rounds, plus results based points from the first four motos of the final round.
5. Any ties at the end of the series will be determined by count back.
6. To gain series points on wet days, riders must be entered and ride at least the first moto.
7. If racing is washed out, points will count from completed motos
8. Sick or injured riders must send a Doctor's Certificate or St. Johns Certificate within seven days of the race to: Eastern Region BMX, P.O Box 235 Frankston VIC 3199.

AWARDS

Metro Plate shields may be purchased for \$25.00 at the first round or for \$30.00 at any subsequent round of the series.

Mini shields will be presented to riders at the conclusion of each round. All riders who qualify for an overall series position will be presented with a 'series plaque' at the final round.

Special awards are available for riders who have qualified for Metro Plate Boards in ten or more years. The awards consist of a plaque for ten continuous years and a certificate for ten years in total. To obtain this "long service" award, riders must apply in writing to the Eastern Region through their Club Delegate. Enquiries regarding 10 year awards can be directed to John Grigg.
